Doctor Surrenders License

An Emporia doctor has surrendered his license to the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts in lieu of further disciplinary proceedings. KSBHA entered into a consent agreement with Chad Everett Sharp, M.D., on Wednesday, February 4, in which he agreed to surrender his Kansas medical license.

The Board began disciplinary proceedings after Dr. Sharp was terminated from a facility. Dr. Sharp previously entered into a consent agreement with the Board in October 2006 in which one of the stipulations was that he was limited in prescribing controlled substances. He is alleged to have violated that stipulation among other violations, including unprofessional conduct, failure to maintain records and professional incompetency.
