Dr. Wasse Zafer's license remains suspended

A Kansas State Board of Healing Arts presiding officer has ruled that the license of Wasse Zafer, D.C., Olathe, shall continue to remain suspended pending a disciplinary hearing.

The Kansas State Board of Healing Arts issued an emergency suspension of Dr. Zafer's chiropractic license in May 2009 because of imminent danger to the public's health and safety. A hearing on the emergency suspension was held in June 2009. The presiding officer issued a ruling Thursday that Dr. Zafer's license shall continue to be suspended pending the outcome of a disciplinary hearing with the Board. That hearing has not been scheduled at this time.

Dr. Zafer has held a Kansas license since 1992 and was previously disciplined by the Board in 2006, wherein he entered into a consent agreement which alleged misleading statements in advertising and paid a fine.
