Petition filed

The Kansas State Board of Healing Arts has filed a disciplinary petition against Dr. Douglas Geenens, D.O., Overland Park, with the Office of Administrative Hearings.

The Board of Healing Arts received complaints alleging violations in standards of care, the prescribing and dispensing of prescription drugs as well as boundary issues. The petition filed alleges 23 violations of statutes.

The Office of Administrative Hearings will schedule a pre-hearing conference which will then be followed by a hearing with a presiding officer. Following the hearing, the presiding officer will issue an initial order. That initial order will then be reviewed by the Board of Healing Arts, who will then issue a final order regarding whether or not to take disciplinary action against Dr. Geenens.

Dr. Geenens license is currently active and he has had a Kansas license since 1989.

The Board has appointed outside counsel to this case and it is being represented by McLeod & Heinrichs law firm in Kansas City, Missouri.
