FINAL ORDER FOLLOWING CONFERENCE HEARING

NOW, on this 26th day of April, 2008, comes on for conference hearing before the Kansas State Board of Healing (“Board”) the request filed by Faiz Ahmed, M.D. (“Licensee”) to terminate requirements imposed by the Consent Order filed February 2, 2004. Licensee does not appear. Dan Riley, Associate Counsel, appears for the Board.

After reviewing the file, hearing the statements of the parties, and being duly advised in the premises, the Board finds, concludes and orders as follows:

1. Licensee agreed to a Consent Order that was approved by the Board and was filed February 2, 2004.

2. In the Consent Order, Licensee agreed to a number of items including that he not see, examine, diagnose or otherwise provide care or treatment to female patients and that such prohibition upon treating female patients shall remain in effect until Licensee is permitted by the Texas State Board of Medical Examiners to resume the care and treatment of female patients.

3. On February 20, 2008, Licensee filed a letter requesting that the requirements of the Consent Order be terminated.

4. As part of his request, Licensee provided evidence that on February 8, 2008, the Texas Medical Board had terminated the Agreed Order dated February 7, 2003, and allowed Licensee to resume the care and treatment of female patients.

5. The Board's Disciplinary Panel has reviewed Licensee's request and does not oppose it.

6. Licensee has successfully completed the conditions imposed upon him and has met all the requirements imposed by the Consent Order.


7. The Consent Order and the requirements imposed upon Licensee by such Order should be terminated.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Licensee's request to terminate the requirements imposed by the Consent Order filed February 2, 2004, should be granted and the Consent Order should hereafter have no further force or effect.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that this is a Final Order. A Final Order is effective upon service. A party to an agency proceeding may seek judicial review of a Final Order by filing a petition in District Court as authorized under the Kansas Act for Judicial Review and Civil Enforcement of Agency Actions, K.S.A. 77-601 *et seq.* A petition for judicial review is not timely unless filed within 30 days following service of the Final Order. A copy of any such petition must be served upon the Board addressed to the Executive Director, 235 S. Topeka Boulevard, Topeka, Kansas 66603. A request for reconsideration is not a prerequisite to judicial review.


