**EMERGENCY ORDER**

**NOW ON THIS** 9th day of April 2008, this matter comes before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”) upon Petitioner’s Motion for Emergency Order Temporarily Suspending License. Dan Riley appears in person on behalf of the Petitioner. Gregory Young appears by telephone on behalf of Terry Farney, D.C. (“Respondent”).

Having the agency record before it, the Board finds, concludes and orders as follows:

1. Respondent does not oppose Petitioner’s Motion for Emergency Order Temporarily Suspending License.
2. The Presiding Officer incorporates herein the findings of fact and conclusions of law which are detailed in the Emergency Order dated April 4, 2008.
3. The Presiding Officer finds and concludes that it is within the best interest of the public health, safety and welfare to continue the temporary suspension of Respondent’s License.

**IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED** that the suspension of Terry Farney, D.C.’s license is hereby ordered to continue in effect until such time that a Final Order is rendered upon the merits of the allegations contained in the Petition or until further order from the Presiding Officer.

**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that this is an emergency order. An emergency order is effective when rendered. A party to an agency proceeding may seek judicial review of an emergency order as a non-final action by filing a petition in the District Court as authorized by

K.S.A. 77-601 *et seq.* A petition for judicial review is not timely unless filed within 30 days following service of the order. A copy of any petition for judicial review must be served upon the Board's Executive Director at 235 S. Topeka Boulevard, Topeka, Kansas 66603-3068.
