ORDER GRANTING THIRD TEMPORARY PERMIT

NOW on this 12th day of August, 1995, this matter comes on for conference proceedings at the request of Myrah Abragan (hereafter "Permittee") to grant a third temporary permit pursuant to K.S.A. 199⁵ Supp. 65-2906(b)(3) and more specifically, K.A.R. 100-36-1.

Lawrence T. Buening, Jr., Executive Director, presented information to the Kansas Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board"). Permittee appears in person *pro se*.

After hearing statements from the parties and Permittee and being duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings of fact, conclusions of law and orders:

- 1) A request for a third temporary permit was submitted by Permittee on August 11, 1995.
- 2) Permittee signed a Voluntary Entry of Appearance and Waiver of Notice on August 12, 1995. Hearing was set for August 12, 1995 at 9:00 a.m.
- 3) Permittee has applied for permanent registration as a physical therapist, but has not passed an exam approved by the Board as required by K.S.A. 1994 Supp. 65-2906(b)(3).
- 4) Pursuant to K.A.R. 100-36-1, not more than two temporary permits shall be permitted to any one person without the majority approval of the members of the Board and for which good cause shall be shown.
- 5) It was determined by the Board that good cause exists to grant Permittee a third temporary permit.

6) Upon payment of the appropriate fees, Permittee should be granted a third temporary permit which shall be valid until the occurrence of any one of the following:

- (a) Permittee, prior to February 28, 1996, provides proof of successful passage of the PES exam; then, the temporary permit will be cancelled on the date the Board issues a permanent registration to Permittee; or
- (b) Permittee, prior to February 28, 1996, fails to provide proof of passage of the PES; then, the temporary permit will be cancelled and of no further force or effect.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED as follows:

a. That upon payment of the appropriate fee, a third temporary permit be granted to Permittee which will be valid until cancelled as provided in paragraph 6 above.

b. That this is a final order and is effective upon service upon the parties. Any party may, within fifteen (15) days of service, file a Petition for Reconsideration. The filing of a Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking administrative or judicial review.

IT IS SO ORDERED.


