JOURNAL ENTRY OF SATISFACTION OF REQUIREMENTS OF CONSENT ORDER

NOW on this day of July, 2009, this matter comes before John (Jack) Confer, Executive Director, Kansas Board of Healing Arts ("Board"), concerning Licensee's satisfaction of all requirements contained in the Consent Order Licensee entered into with the Board which was filed on October 14, 2008 and modified on February 20, 2009. Wherefore, the Board finds as follows:

- 1. On or about October 14, 2008, Licensee entered into a Consent Order with the Board to address concerns about his prescribing practices. The Consent Order contained a provision for Licensee to complete a DVD prescribing course at his own expense no later than December 31, 2008.
- 2. On February 20, 2009, Licensee came before the Board and requested to modify the Consent Order filed on October 14, 2008, to allow him to complete the Mercer University's College of Pharmacy and Health Sciences "Appropriate Prescribing of Controlled Substances: A Symposium for Physicians and Dentists" in lieu of the previously approved University of Medicine and Dentistry of New Jersey's Mini-Residency Appropriate Prescribing Course on DVD. This request was granted.
- 3. Licensee has provided documentation of completion the Mercer University's College of Pharmacy and Health Sciences "Appropriate Prescribing of Controlled Substances: A

Symposium for Physicians and Dentists on June 13, 2009.

- 3. Licensee has satisfied the requirement of the Consent Order which required that he complete a prescribing course.
- 4. Licensee is required to continue to maintain compliance with regard to paragraph "b" of the Consent Order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Licensee is hereby discharged from the requirement of the Consent Order filed on October 14, 2008, and modified on February 20, 2009, to complete the Mercer University's College of Pharmacy and Health Sciences "Appropriate Prescribing of Controlled Substances: A Symposium for Physicians and Dentists.
