FINAL ORDER EXTENDING TEMPORARY LICENSE

NOW, on this 13th day of August, 2005, comes on for conference hearing before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board") the request of Demie Ahlquist, P.A. ("Petitioner") to extend herTemporary License Number 0525604 to practice as a physician assistant. Charlene K. Abbott, Licensing Administrator, presented information to the Board. Petitioner appeared in person *pro se*. There were no other appearances.

After hearing the information provided by Charlene K. Abbott and Petitioner and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings and orders:

- 1. Petitioner was issued a temporary license to practice as a Physician Assistant on September 2, 2004 which was effective for one year through September 2, 2005, as specified by K.S.A. 65-28a07(b).
 - 2. On August 10, 2005, Petitioner filed a request for extension of her temporary license.
- 3. K.S.A. 65-28a07(b) allows the Board to extend a temporary license, upon a majority vote of the members of the Board, for a period not to exceed one year.
- 4. Petitioner has filed a Voluntary Entry of Appearance and Waiver of Notice in which she waived notice of hearing on her request for an extension of her temporary license.

5. The Board finds that sufficient cause exists to extend Petitioner's temporary license until September 2, 2006.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Temporary License Number 0525604 be extended until September 2, 2006 and be considered to have been continuously effective from and since its original date of issuance on September 2, 2004.
