FINAL ORDER

NOW, on this Sixteenth Day of October, 2004 comes before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board"), a request by Muhammad Qadeer Akram, P.A. (hereafter "Petitioner") to extend his temporary license and to make his temporary license retroactively effective from and after September 25, 2004.

Charlene Abbott, Licensing Administrator, presents information to the Board. Petitioner appears in person *pro se*.

After hearing statement of the parties and being duly advised in the premises, the Board finds as follows:

1. Petitioner submitted an *Application for Physician Assistant License* received on July 28, 2003.
2. Petitioner was issued a temporary license to practice as a Physician Assistant on September 25, 2003 to expire September 25, 2004.
3. Petitioner failed the NCCPA examination on July 14, 2004 and repeated the exam on October 13, 2004. The results of that exam are not yet available.
4. Petitioner provided a copy of a certificate from CME Resources for participation in an Exam Review Course:
5. Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-28a07(b) a temporary license is valid for one year from the date of issuance or until the Board makes a final determination on the application's request for licensure. The Board may extend a temporary license,

upon a majority vote of the members of the board, for a period not to exceed one year.

6. The Board finds sufficient cause exists to grant Petitioner's request to extend his temporary license to practice as a Physician Assistant until December 11, 2004 and to make such extension retroactively effective from and after September 25, 2004.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:
