**FINAL ORDER DENYING REINSTATEMENT OF LICENSURE**

NOW on this 10<sup>th</sup> day of April 2015, comes before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”) the application of Muhammed Akram, P.A. (“Applicant”) for reinstatement of his license to practice as a physician assistant in the State of Kansas. Applicant appears in person and by and through counsel James T. McIntyre of the Law Offices of James T. McIntyre. Jessica A. Bryson, Associate Litigation Counsel, appears on behalf of the Respondent Board.

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Board by K.S.A. 65-28a01 *et seq.* and in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, the Board hereby enters this Final Order in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the agency record, hearing the statements and arguments of the parties, and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings, conclusions and order:

1. Applicant was previously licensed to engage in the practice as a physician assistant in the State of Kansas, having been issued License No. 15-01015 on approximately April 23, 2005. His license was cancelled for failure to renew on January 1, 2013.
2. On or about November 4, 2013, Applicant submitted an application for reinstatement of his Kansas license to practice as a physician assistant. Such was application deemed complete and filed with the Board on February 26, 2015.

3. On or about March 10, 2015, Associate Litigation Counsel filed a Response in Opposition to Application to Reinstate License to Practice as a Physician Assistant (“Response”). The allegations contained in the Response are incorporated by reference herein.

4. The Board finds that Applicant plead guilty to three felony offenses on or about September 10, 2011. These offenses were Conspiracy to Defraud the U.S. Department of Agriculture, Food Stamp Fraud, and Wire Fraud.

5. The Board finds that on or about December 28, 2011, Applicant answered “no” on his renewal application to the question that asked if he had been arrested, charged or convicted of any felony in the last twelve months.

6. The Board finds that on or about September 28, 2011, Applicant was terminated from his position as a physician assistant at Galichia Heart Hospital in Wichita due to his felony convictions which were a violation of the code of conduct.

7. The Board finds that on or about December 28, 2011, Applicant answered “no” on his renewal application to the question that asked whether any action had been taken against his privileges related to his profession as a healthcare provider.

8. The Board further finds that as a result of Applicant’s “no” answers on his application for renewal, Applicant’s license was renewed for the period of January 1, 2012 to December 31, 2012.

9. The Board finds that on or about December 7, 2011, Applicant was sentenced to serve eighteen (18) months imprisonment and three (3) years of supervised release. Applicant served his sentence of imprisonment from July 24, 2012 to August 21, 2013.

10. The Board finds that Applicant benefited financially from his crimes. The Board further finds that Applicant was dishonest in answering the renewal application questions when

he failed to answer “yes” to the questions regarding prior felony convictions and his termination from Galichia Heart Hospital.

11. The Board concludes that Applicant violated K.S.A. 65-28a05(d), in that he has been convicted of a felony offense.

12. The Board further concludes that Applicant violated K.S.A. 65-28a05(a), as further defined by K.A.R. 100-28a-8(b) and K.S.A. 65-28a05(b), in that Applicant obtained his license for the renewal period of January 1, 2012 to December 31, 2012, by means of fraud, misrepresentation, or concealment or material facts.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, BY THE KANSAS STATE BOARD OF HEALING ARTS** that Applicant’s application for reinstatement of license to practice as a physician assistant in the State of Kansas is hereby **DENIED**.


