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STIPULATION

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KANSAS STATE BOARD OF

THIS AGREEMENT made and entered into this 05th 9 1988

day of December, 1988, by and between the **KANSAS STATE BOARD OF HEALING ARTS**, (hereinafter referred to as "Board") and **ALAN ALBARRACIN, M.D.** (hereinafter referred to as "Licensee").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Licensee is currently licensed to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas and holds license number 19287; and

WHEREAS, on November 7, 1988, Licensee appeared before Mr. Richard G. Gannon, Executive Director of the Board to discuss matters pertaining to his ability to safely practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas, pursuant to K.S.A. 1987 Supp. 65-2836 through 65-2844 and amendments thereto; and

WHEREAS, after a thorough investigation by the Disciplinary Counsel there is cause to believe that Licensee may have committed acts for which a formal adjudicative hearing would be necessary in order to revoke, suspend, or limit Licensee's license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas or take other disciplinary action against Licensee; and

WHEREAS, in lieu of the prosecution of charges at a formal adjudicative hearing, the parties mutually desire to enter into a Stipulation.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of a formal adjudicative hearing and other covenants and promises contained herein, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. That, Licensee shall participate in at least 50 hours of continuing education for obstetrics and gynecology.
2. That, Licensee shall immediately cease and desist from performing epidural blocks.
3. That, Licensee's patient records shall conform to

K.A.R. 100-24-1 (Attached as Exhibit 1).


4. That, as long as Licensee remains in strict compliance with the terms and conditions of this Stipulation, no formal adjudicative proceedings will be initiated against Licensee based upon the aforementioned items. Any violation of any of the terms and conditions of this Stipulation by the Licensee shall be prima facie evidence that a violation of the Healing Arts Act has occurred for which the Board may suspend, revoke, or limit the license of the Licensee.

5. That, it is further agreed and understood that the provisions of this Stipulation are to be strictly construed and adhered to. This Stipulation constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and there are no other agreements and understandings not set forth herein. This Stipulation may be modified or amended only by written instrument signed by the parties hereto.

6. That, this Stipulation shall remain in full force and effect until modified, amended, or rescinded by the parties hereto. Licensee may request an appearance before the Board to discuss modification, amendment, or rescission of this Stipulation and the Board will give such request due consideration.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the parties hereto have executed this Stipulation on the date indicated below their signature, it being strictly understood that the effective date of this Stipulation will be the date it has been signed by both parties hereto.

ENFORCEMENT ORDER


NOW, on this 20th day of January, 1989, this matter comes before the Board as a result of the Stipulation having been entered into between the Board and the above-named individual. The Kansas State Board of Healing Arts appears by and through its Disciplinary Counsel, Joseph M. Furjanic. Alan Albarracin, M.D. did not appear.

After examining the file, reviewing the existing Stipulation and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board finds as follows:

1. That the Board and Licensee have heretofore entered into a Stipulation dated December 9, 1988.
2. That Licensee shall participate in at least 50 hours of continuing medical education for obstetrics and gynecology and shall immediately cease and desist from performing epidural blocks.
3. That Licensee's patient records shall conform to K.A.R. 100-24-1.
4. That any violation of this Stipulation by Licensee during the time the Stipulation remains in effect shall constitute prima facie evidence of a violation of the Healing Arts Act and formal adjudicative proceedings may be initiated against said Licensee for the revocation, suspension or limitation of said Licensee's license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas.
