
WHEREUPON, the Board having the agency record before it, being duly advised in the premises and hearing the statements and arguments of the parties, FINDS and ORDERS as follows:

1. On or about August 20, 2007, Licensee entered into a Consent Order with the Board.
2. One of the conditions of the Consent Order required Licensee's records to be monitored for a period of not less than six (6) months by Coding & Compliance Initiatives, Inc.
3. On or about May 27, 2009, Licensee requested that the monitoring be terminated.
4. The Board finds that Licensee has been monitored for approximately 18 months and that continued monitoring is no longer necessary to protect the health, safety and welfare of the public.
5. It is therefore ordered that Licensee is released from the record monitoring provisions of the Consent Order. All other provisions of the Consent Order remain in full force and effect.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that this is a final order. A final order is effective upon service. A party to an agency proceeding may seek judicial review of a final order by filing a petition in the District Court as authorized by K.S.A. 77-601, et seq. Reconsideration of a final order is not a prerequisite to judicial review. A petition for judicial review is not timely unless filed within 30 days following service of the final order. A copy of any petition for judicial review must be served upon the Board's Executive Director at 235 SW. Topeka Blvd., Topeka, KS 66603.
