OF CONSENT ORDER FILED DECEMBER 4, 2006**


**NOW** on this 26<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2010, this matter comes before the Kansas Board of Healing Arts ("Board") concerning Licensee's satisfaction of the education requirement contained in the Consent Order Licensee entered into with the Board and filed on November 7, 2006. Wherefore, the Board finds as follows:

1. Pursuant to the terms of the Consent Order, Licensee was required to pay a fine of \$200.00 and complete a continuing education course for ethics and provide proof of successful completion by December 15, 2007.
2. On or about November 9, 2006, the Board received full payment of the fine from Licensee in the amount of \$200.00.
3. On or about February 3, 2006, Licensee successfully completed Biomedical Ethics- Delivering Bad News: A Cultural and Religious Analysis, which was offered by the U.S. Army Medical Command. The parties contemplated that this course would meet the particular concerns underlying the Consent Order and Licensee attended it before the Consent Order was entered.
4. Licensee has satisfied all requirements of the Consent Order and has no further obligation for compliance.




