**FINAL ORDER GRANTING WITHDRAWAL OF APPLICATION**

NOW on this 9th day of August, 2013, comes before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board") the application of Alexander Nelson, D.C. ("Applicant") for an active license to practice chiropractic in the State of Kansas. Applicant appears in person and *pro se*. Reese Hays, Associate Litigation Counsel, appears on behalf of the Respondent Board.

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Board by K.S.A. 65-2801 *et seq.* and in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, the Board hereby enters this Final Order in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the agency record, the evidence presented, and hearing the statements and arguments of the parties, and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings, conclusions and order:


1. On or about May 9, 2013, Alexander Nelson ("Applicant") submitted an application to the Board for active licensure by endorsement pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2833.
2. Applicant graduated from Cleveland Chiropractic College in December 2012.
3. Applicant does not hold a baccalaureate degree.
4. Applicant has held a Missouri license since December 31, 2012.
5. Applicant does not meet the requirements for licensure by examination under K.A.R. 100-6-2(d) due to not having a baccalaureate degree.

6. Applicant requests the Board grant withdrawal of his application for active licensure by endorsement.

7. The Board accepts such withdrawal of Applicant's application.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, BY THE KANSAS STATE BOARD OF HEALING ARTS,** that Applicant's request to withdraw his application for active licensure by endorsement to practice chiropractic in the State of Kansas is hereby accepted.


