JOURNAL ENTRY


This matter comes on for consideration before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereinafter referred to as "Board") and Rocky A. Altic (hereinafter referred to as "Applicant") for consideration of Applicant's application for certification as a certified physical therapist assistant.

On April 11, 1992, a conference hearing was conducted to determine whether the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts should grant or deny Applicant's application for certification as a certified physical therapist. The Board appeared by and through Steve A. Schwarm, General Counsel. Applicant appeared pro se. Administrative notice was taken that the Board issued a Notice of Conference Hearing on March 27, 1992, setting the matter for consideration at 9:00 a.m. on April 11, 1992. Members present were John White, D.O., President/Presiding; Rex Wright, D.C., Vice-President; Franklin Bichlmeier, M.D.; Donald Bletz, M.D.; Jimmy Buller, D.O.; Howard Ellis, M.D.; Edward Fitzgerald, M.D.; Harold Guldner; Richard Uhlig, D.O.; Irwin Waxman, D.P.M.; and Kenneth Wedel, M.D. After hearing statement from Counsel for the Board, and statement from Applicant, the Board ordered that the application be forwarded to the Physical Therapy Examining Committee for recommendations on experience and training, and report back to the Board at the June 1992 Board meeting.

On June 12, 1992, at the regularly scheduled June 1992 Board meeting, with the following Board members present- John White, D.O., President/ Presiding; Rex Wright, D.C., Vice-President; Franklin Bichlmeier, M.D.; Donald Bletz, M.D.; Jimmy Buller, D.O.; Harold Ellis, M.D.; Harold Guldner; Mark Hatesohl, D.C.; Graciela Marion; John Petersen; Kenneth Wedel, M.D.; Ronald Zoeller, D.C.- the Board heard a report from Kevin LaChance, Associate Counsel for the Board, and Joan Arterburn, of the Physical Therapy Examining Committee. Applicant was reported to have possessed the necessary work experience and training to meet the requirements of certification, as determined by the Physical Therapy Examining Committee. Further, Applicant had successfully passed the National Physical Therapy Examination given by Assessment Systems, Incorporated. After due consideration, the Board voted to grant Applicant certification as a physical therapist assistant.

It is therefore ordered that certification is hereby granted Applicant.


