ORDER GRANTING SECOND TEMPORARY REGISTRATION

NOW on this 8th day of December, 1995, this matter comes on for conference proceedings before the full Board at the request of Monica Ayuma Amunga (hereinafter "Registrant") to grant a second temporary registration pursuant to K.S.A. 65-5408(d).

Charlene K. Abbott, Licensing Administrator, presents information to the Kansas Board of Healing Arts (hereinafter "Board"). There are no other appearances.

After reviewing the file, hearing statements of the parties and being duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings of fact , conclusions of law and orders:

1. A request for second temporary registration was received from Registrant on October 12, 1995.
2. Notice of Conference Hearing setting this matter for hearing at 9:15 a.m. on December 8, 1995 was filed herein on November 22, 1995 and served on Registrant on that same date.
3. Registrant has applied for permanent registration as an occupational therapist, but has not passed an exam approved by the Board as required by K.S.A. 65-5406(a)(3).

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4. Registrant was granted temporary registration number 9401967, which expired March 15, 1995.

5. Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-5408(d), not more than one temporary registration shall be permitted to any one person without the majority approval of the members of the Board.

6. The Board finds that sufficient cause exists to grant Registrant a second temporary registration.

7. Upon payment of the appropriate fees, Registrant should be granted a second temporary registration until results from the AOTCB examination to be administered in January of 1996 become available.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED as follows:

A. That upon payment of the appropriate fee, a second temporary registration be granted to registrant until the Board receives the results from the AOTCB examination to be administered in January, 1996.

B. That in the event Registrant fails to pass the AOTCB examination to be administered in January, 1996, the second temporary registration hereby granted to Registrant should expire and be cancelled as of the date of the next regularly scheduled meeting of the Board following the date the failure of said exam becomes available to the Board.

C. That this is a Final Order and is effective upon service upon the parties. Any party may, within fifteen (15) days after service, file a Petition for Reconsideration. The filing of a Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking administrative or judicial review.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
