**JOURNAL ENTRY**

**NOW** on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2005, comes Lawrence T. Buening, Jr., Executive Director of the Kansas Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board") and finds and states as follows:

1. On March 1, 2005, the Board filed and served a *Notice of Hearing on Motion for Suspension of License*. The notice was mailed to Respondent at 4213 Roanoke, Hutchinson, Kansas 67502 and to Lawrence W. Williamson, Jr., 1400 Epic Center, 301 N. Main, Wichita, Kansas 67202.

2. Respondent did not attend the hearing on March 1, 2005.

3. On March 16, 2005 the Board filed and served a *Proposed Default Order* suspending Respondent's license until such time as **Confidential** required by the *Proposed Default Order* dated January 27, 2005.

4. K.S.A. 77-520 provides that a party against whom a Proposed Default Order is issued may file a written motion within seven days after service of the order requesting that the order be vacated, and if a motion is not so filed, the Proposed Default Order shall become effective.

5. Respondent has not filed a motion requesting that the Proposed Default Order be vacated and, therefore, by operation of law, the Proposed Default Order became effective March 31, 2005, and Respondent's license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas is suspended as of that date.




4. The Presiding Officer finds and concludes that the license of Velupillai Anandanadesan, M.D. should be suspended until such time as he complies with the order




