**AGREED TEMPORARY ORDER OF SUSPENSION**

NOW on this 25<sup>th</sup> day of August 2010, this matter comes before the Presiding Officer upon Petitioner's Motion for *Ex Parte* Emergency Order of Suspension. Petitioner appears through Associate Litigation Counsel, Julia A. Mowers and Litigation Counsel, Kelli J. Stevens. Licensee appears through counsel, Michael E. Francis. Whereupon, the parties announce that they have reached an agreement in this matter as set forth below.

The Presiding Officer, having reviewed the Petition, Motion and otherwise being apprised in the premises, finds, concludes and orders as follows:

1. The Motion seeks an emergency order of suspension pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2838 and 77-536. Pursuant to those statutes, the Presiding Officer may issue an order to temporarily limit or suspend a license if the Presiding Officer finds an imminent danger to the public health, safety, or welfare.
2. Petitioner's Motion in the above-captioned case incorporates a disciplinary petition filed on the same date that alleges Licensee has the inability to practice with reasonable skill and safety to patients (confidential)

- 3. Petitioner's Motion generally alleges that Licensee committed acts of sexual misconduct and practiced osteopathic medicine outside the scope of his license without sufficient insurance. These acts create an imminent danger of a risk of harm to patients.
- 4. At all times relevant to the allegations set forth in the Petition and Motion, Licensee has held a current federally active license to engage in the practice of osteopathic medicine through the State of Kansas.
- 5. Licensee presently has a federally active and unrestricted license to practice osteopathic medicine through the state of Kansas.




