FINAL ORDER GRANTING POSTGRADUATE PERMIT

NOW on this 17th day of June 2011, comes before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”) the application of Sharique Aslam Ansari, M.D. (“Applicant”) for a postgraduate permit to practice medicine and surgery in a full time, approved training program in the University of Kansas Medical Center’s Neurology/Clinical Neurophysiology Department. Licensee appears *pro se* by telephone. Jessica Bryson, Associate Litigation Counsel, appears on behalf of the Respondent Board.

Pursuant to the authority granted to Board by K.S.A. 65-2801 *et seq.* and in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, the Board hereby enters this Final Order in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the file, hearing the statements and arguments of Ms. Bryson, hearing the testimony of the Applicant and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings of fact, conclusions and order:

1. Licensee’s last known mailing address provided to the Board is: confidential confidential , Omaha, Nebraska 68134.

2. On or about May 10, 2011, Applicant submitted to the Board an application for a postgraduate permit to practice medicine and surgery in a full time, approved training program in the University of Kansas Medical Center’s Neurology/Clinical Neurophysiology Department.

3. Applicant received a Doctor of Medicine degree from the University of Sint Eustatius School of Medicine (“Sint Eustatius”) in June of 2007.

4. Sint Eustatius is not an accredited school and has not been in existence for (15) fifteen years.

5. Applicant currently holds an active Temporary Educational Permit to practice medicine in Nebraska.

6. Applicant has completed a three (3) year residency program in Neurology at the University of Nebraska Medical Center in Omaha, Nebraska under the authority of his Nebraska Educational Permit.


7. Applicant has completed the USMLE Step 1, Step 2 CK and Step 2 CS. Applicant has not yet completed Step 3.

8. Applicant requests the Board grant a postgraduate permit by endorsement based upon Applicant’s Nebraska Temporary Educational Permit.

9. For the sole purpose of granting a postgraduate permit by endorsement pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2811(b) and K.S.A. 65-2833, Applicant’s Nebraska Temporary Educational Permit and his practice thereunder are found to be satisfactory.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, BY THE KANSAS STATE BOARD OF HEALING ARTS that Applicant is hereby granted a postgraduate permit by endorsement in Kansas effective July 1, 2011.


