JOURNAL ENTRY

NOW, on this 8th day of April, 2008, the above-entitled matter comes on before Lawrence T. Buening, Jr., Executive Director of the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board"). After reviewing the filing and being duly advised in the premises, the Executive Director makes the following determinations:

1. On May 14, 2007, William J. Arkell, D.O. ("Applicant") filed an Application for Reinstatement of his license to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas. The Application for Reinstatement was deemed complete on November 20, 2007.
2. On November 20, 2007, the Board filed a Response in Opposition to the Application for Reinstatement of License to Practice Osteopathic Medicine and Surgery.
3. On November 21, 2007, Applicant was mailed a Notice of Conference Hearing notifying him that a conference hearing would be held on Applicant's Application for Reinstatement at 11:00 a.m. on December 8, 2007. The Notice was mailed to the mailing address indicated on the Application for Reinstatement.

4. On December 4, 2007, Applicant faxed information to the Board modifying the answers previously provided on the Application for Reinstatement submitted May 143, 2007.

5. Applicant did not appear at the hearing on December 8, 2007, but due to inclement weather that day, the Board continued the conference hearing.

6. On February 5, 2008, Applicant was mailed a Notice of Conference Hearing notifying him that a conference hearing would be held on the Application for Reinstatement at 9:00 a.m. on February 23, 2008. This Notice was also sent to the mailing address indicated on the Application for Reinstatement.

7. Applicant failed to attend or participate in the Conference Hearing and the Board issued a Proposed Default Order which was filed on March 4, 2008, and served on all parties on that date.


8. K.S.A. 77-520(b) provides and the Proposed Default Order contained a notice that within seven days after service, the party against whom a proposed default order is issued may file a written motion requesting that the proposed default order be vacated.

9. K.S.A. 77-520(c) provides and the Proposed Default Order contained a notice that a proposed default order shall become effective after the expiration of the time within which a party may file a written motion requesting that the proposed default order be vacated unless a written motion to vacate the order is filed within such time.

10. Applicant has not filed a written motion to vacate the Proposed Default Order and, therefore, the Proposed Default Order became effective as an order of the Board and the Application for Reinstatement was denied effective March 17, 2008.


