# PROPOSED DEFAULT ORDER DENYING LICENSE TO PRACTICE RADIOLOGIC TECHNOLOGY

On April 12, 2019, the Kansas Board of Healing Arts (Board) held a conference hearing on Licensee's Application for Licensure in to practice Radiologic Technology in Kansas. Michael Arnold (Applicant) appeared not. Matthew Gaus, Associate Litigation Counsel, appeared to present the response in opposition to the application on behalf of the disciplinary panel of the Board. The members of the disciplinary panel were recused from the Board's consideration of this matter.

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Board by K.S.A. 65-6901 *et seq.* and in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, the Board enters this Proposed Default Order in the above-captioned matter.

Upon review of the Applicant's application, the Board's Response in Opposition to Applicant's licensure, exhibits submitted, and being fully advised in the premise, the Board holds Licensee in DEFAULT for his failure to appear at the April 12, 2019 conference hearing on this matter, DENIES Applicant's Application for Licensure, and makes the following determinations:

#### Facts:

- 1. A conference hearing on Applicant's application for licensure was noticed for April 12, 2019, at the offices of the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts.
- 2. Pursuant to K.S.A. 2012 Supp. 77-531, Applicant was served with a Notice of Conference Hearing to Applicant's mailing address via United States Mail, first-class postage prepaid, on or about March 6, 2019. The Notice of Conference Hearing provided Applicant notice that any party who fails to attend or participate in the Conference Hearing or other stage of a proceeding may be held in default.
- 3. Applicant failed to appear at the Conference Hearing held on April 12, 2019.
- 4. The Board finds the facts set forth in the Response in Opposition to Applicant's application to practice radiologic technology are undisputed and are incorporated here by reference.

### Conclusions of Law

Pursuant to K.S.A. 77-520, Licensee is in default for his failure to appear at the conference hearing on April 12, 2019.

The Board concludes Applicant's application should be denied due to uncontested violations of the Radiologic Technology Practice Act as described in the Response in Opposition to Application for License to Practice as a Radiologic Technologist, incorporated here by reference.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, BY THE KANSAS STATE BOARD OF HEALING ARTS that Licensee is hereby held in DEFAULT pursuant to K.S.A. 77-520.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Applicant's Application for Licensure is DENIED.
