## SUMMARY ORDER OF CANCELLATION OF LICENSE

**NOW ON THIS** 11<sup>TH</sup> day of October, 2000, comes Lawrence T. Buening, Jr., Executive Director of the Kansas Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board"), serving as Presiding Officer in summary proceedings. Constantine Arvanitakis (hereafter "Licensee") does not appear.

The Presiding Officer specifies the following findings of fact, conclusions of law and reasons for actions:

- 1. On December 7, 1973, Licensee's was issued license number 14524 to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas.
- 2. On or about June 20, 2000, the Board received Licensee's Renewal Application for Medicine and Surgery, along with a check numbered 2294, drawn upon the Johnson County National Bank and Trust Company, Prairie Village, Kansas, in the amount of \$90.00.
- 3. As a result of receipt of said check and application for renewal, Licensee was issued receipt # 106324 indicating Licensee's license to practice in the state of Kansas had been renewed for the period of July 1, 2000 through June 30, 2001.
- 4. The Board has received notification from the State Treasurer's Office that Licensee's aforementioned check had been returned not paid and marked "REFER TO MAKER".
- 5. Board staff attempted to contact Licensee by telephone at the Overland Park, Kansas address printed on check number 2294 but was unsuccessful.

6. On July 31, 2000, Licensee was notified by first class mail that his check had been

returned to our office marked "REFER TO MAKER" and his license would be canceled effective

August 1, 2000 if a replacement in the amount of \$105.00, which included a processing fee for

the returned check, was not received by August 30, 2000.

7. To date, Licensee has failed to respond and Licensee's license to practice medicine and

surgery in the state of Kansas should be canceled for failure to renew as provided by K.S.A. 1999

Supp.65-2809.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the license of Licensee issued by the Board to

practice medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas be canceled.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Licensee is entitled to request a hearing on this Order,

in writing, to the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts, 235 S. Topeka Boulevard, Topeka, Kansas

66603-3068 within fifteen (15) days of service of this Order and if a hearing is not requested

within the time and manner as stated above, this decision becomes final and effective upon the

expiration of the time for requesting a hearing.
