JOURNAL ENTRY


NOW, on this 14th day of July, 2003, comes Lawrence T. Buening, Jr., Executive Director of the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board") and determines as follows:

1. Maher Ayyash, M.D. ("Applicant") has submitted an application for licensure to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas.
2. Formal proceedings on Applicant's application were conducted on January 6, 2003, by Board member Carolina M. Soria, D.O. who issued an Initial Order that was filed February 10, 2003.
3. At its meeting conducted April 26, 2003, the Board as a whole conducted a review of the Initial Order.
4. In the Final Order issued by the Board and filed April 30, 2003, the Board ordered that Applicant's application for licensure should be granted upon Applicant's completion of the course *Maintaining Proper Boundaries*, offered June 25-27, 2003 by Vanderbilt University Medical Center.
5. The Board has received certification from Vanderbilt University Medical Center that Applicant completed the course as directed by the Board.
6. As a result of Applicant's compliance with the Final Order issued by the Board, Applicant has met all the requirement to have his application for licensure to practice medicine and surgery granted by the Board.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that a temporary permit to practice medicine and surgery be issued to Applicant effective July 7, 2003, and that Applicant's application be considered by the Board for the issuance of a permanent and unrestricted license at its meeting to be held August 23, 2003.




Dear Ms. Benintendi:


