NOW, on this 18th day of October, 1997, this matter comes on before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereinafter "Board") sitting as a whole, the application of Lolitta E. Aznaurova, M.D., (hereinafter "Applicant") for a permanent license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas.

Applicant appeared <u>pro se</u>. Charlene Abbott, Licensing Administrator of the Board, presented information to the Board.

After reviewing the file, hearing statements and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board finds as follows:

- 1. On July 23, 1997, Applicant filed an Application to obtain a permanent license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas.
- 2. As part of that application, Applicant provided information and documentation regarding postgraduate training which had been obtained by

Applicant. The information provided by Applicant reflected she had obtained postgraduate training at Hospital #1 in Baku, Azerbaijan and the University of Kansas Medical Center.

- 3. After several attempts, Applicant has also been unable to obtain a Certificate of Professional College from Baku, Azerbaijan.
- 4. The Board reviewed the application and determined that the information which had been provided by Applicant regarding her postgraduate training was acceptable to the Board to satisfy the requirements of K.A.R. 100-6-2.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED as follows:

- a) That the findings here and above made be in the same are made the Order of the Board.
- b) Applicant has met the requirements of K.A.R. 100-6-2 in that she has provided evidence of completion of 2 years of postgraduate training approved by the Board.
- (c) The Board waives the requirements of Section VIII of the application noting that Applicant has made diligent efforts to obtain the Certificate of Professional College from Azerbaijan State Medical Institute, Baku, Azerbaijan and

has provided information equivalent to that required by Section VIII of the application..

(d) Applicant's application is complete except passage of an examination required by K.S.A. 65-2873(a)(3) and Applicant is eligible to sit for USMLE, Step III and to be granted a permanent license upon providing proof of passage of such examination.

(e) Either party is entitled to an administrative review of this Order if written request is received in the Board office within fifteen (15) days of service of this Order upon the parties.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
