FINAL ORDER

NOW ON THIS Twenty-third Day of June, 2001, comes before the Board a Petition to Revoke, Suspend or Otherwise Limit the License of Respondent George J. Bauler, D.O. Stacy L. Cook, Litigation Counsel, appears for Petitioner. Respondent appears in person.

After hearing testimony and having the agency record before it, the Board finds, concludes, and orders as follows:

1. On January 11, 2001, Respondent appeared in the District Court for Sedgewick County, Kansas and pleaded nolo contendere to one count of attempted aggravated indecent liberties with a child, a felony. Judgement was entered April 27, 2001, convicting Respondent of the crime.

2. The Board does not find by a two-thirds majority that there is clear and convincing evidence Respondent is sufficiently rehabilitated to warrant the public trust.

3. K.S.A. 2000 Supp. 65-2836(c) requires that the Board revoke a license to practice the healing arts upon a finding that a licensee has been convicted of a felony unless the Board finds, by a two-thirds majority, that there is clear and convincing evidence the licensee has been sufficiently rehabilitated to warrant the public trust.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that the license of George J. Bauler, D.O., is revoked.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that this is a Final Order. A Final Order is effective upon service. A party may seek judicial review of a Final Order by filing a petition under the Kansas act for judicial review and civil enforcement of agency actions, K.S.A. 77-601, *et seq.* A petition for judicial review is not timely unless filed within 30 days of the Final Order. A copy of any such petition must be served upon the Board addressed to the Executive Director, 235 S. Topeka Blvd., Topeka, Kansas 66603. Reconsideration is not a prerequisite to judicial review.
