FINAL ORDER TERMINATING CONSENT ORDER

NOW, on this 12th day of August 2016, comes before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board") the Petition to Terminate Consent Order filed by Alicia Bean, M.D. ("Licensee"), requesting termination of her Consent Order with the Board that was filed on August 24, 2010. Licensee appears in person and through counsel, Mark Stafford. Jane Weiler, Associate Litigation Counsel, appears on behalf of the Board.

Pursuant to the authority granted to Board by K.S.A. 65-2801 *et seq.* and in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, the Board hereby enters this Final Order following a conference hearing in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the agency record, hearing the testimony and arguments of the parties, and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings, conclusions and order:

1. Licensee is licensed to engage in the practice of medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas, having been issued License No. 04-34611 in 2010.
2. On August 24, 2010, Licensee entered into a Consent Order with the Board as a condition to being granted licensure in order to resolve concerns regarding Licensee having been placed on probation during postgraduate training and **Confidential** that could affect her ability to safely practice.

3. The Consent Order required Licensee to do the following:
 - a. Practice under supervision for at least six (6) months with monthly reporting to the Board;
 - b. Confidential
 - c. Confidential

4. On October 27, 2011, the Board issued a Final Order Terminating Supervision Requirement based upon Licensee's satisfactory compliance with the practice supervision requirement.

5. On December 20, 2013, the Board issued a Final Order Granting the Request for Termination of Monitoring based upon Licensee's satisfactory compliance with all the terms and conditions Confidential

6. On or about July 5, 2016, Licensee filed a Petition to Terminate Consent Order with the Board which requested termination of Consent Order's sole remaining requirement of Confidential

7. On July 13, 2016, Associate Litigation Counsel filed a "Response to Petition for Termination of Confidential" which indicated that Licensee has been compliant Confidential

8. The Board finds that Licensee has satisfactorily met the Consent Order's remaining requirement **Confidential** and concludes that termination of the Consent Order is warranted in the circumstances.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, BY THE KANSAS STATE BOARD OF HEALING ARTS that the Consent Order filed with the Board on August 24, 2010, is hereby **TERMINATED.**

Additionally, a party to an agency proceeding may seek judicial review of a Final Order by filing a petition in the District Court, as authorized by K.S.A. 77-601, *et seq.* Reconsideration of a Final Order is not a prerequisite to judicial review. A petition for judicial review is not timely unless filed within **30 days** following service of the Final Order.
