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STIPULATION

KANSAS BOARD OF HEALING ARTS

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this 3rd day of January, 198~~5~~<sup>6</sup>, by and between the KANSAS STATE BOARD OF HEALING ARTS, hereinafter referred to as "Board" and CHANDLER S. BETHEL, M.D., hereinafter referred to as "Licensee".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Licensee is the holder of license #12458 which was most recently renewed by the Board on the 13th day of June, 1985, and which remains active and in full force and effect; and

WHEREAS, on or about May 23, 1985 the Board received a report pursuant to K.S.A. 65-28,121 that Licensee may have committed a violation of the Kansas Healing Arts Act; and

WHEREAS, during the course of the investigation of the aforementioned report and the conduct therein alleged Licensee has complied with all requests and orders of the Board including  
(confidential) completion of certain postgraduate training and voluntary agreement to hold any action to apply for or reinstate hospital privileges; and

WHEREAS, the Board has received no further information alleging professional incompetency or any violation of the Healing Arts Act by the Licensee from and since receipt of the aforementioned report; and

WHEREAS, in lieu of initiation of formal adjudicative proceedings to revoke, suspend or limit the license of Licensee based upon the aforementioned report and the information obtained by the Board during the course of its investigation, the parties are desirous of entering into this stipulation.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the forbearance of formal adjudicative proceedings and the conditions, covenants and promises contained herein, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. That Licensee shall be entitled to forthwith apply for medical staff privileges at any such hospitals or other institutions as he may desire.
2. That Licensee shall provide to the Board copies of all applications made for medical staff privileges or reinstatement of such privileges at any hospitals within ten days of submission of such applications and shall further notify the Board upon his being advised of receipt of privileges at any hospitals to which application is made.

5. That this stipulation shall constitute a release, consent and authorization by the Licensee for the Board to receive periodic progress reports (confidential) referred to in paragraph 3 above and the chief of the medical staff of all hospitals or other institutions where Licensee may obtain privileges, it being specifically understood the Board intends to request such reports (confidential) once every two months and once a month from the chief of the medical staff where Licensee may receive privileges.

6. By entering into this stipulation Licensee waives any and all rights of due process which may be afforded to him by the Kansas and United States Constitutions and the Kansas Administrative Act.

7. The provisions of this stipulation are to be strictly construed and adhered to. In the event any of the conditions herein stated are not fully met, this stipulation, at the option of the Board shall become null and void and the Board shall have the right to initiate formal adjudicative proceedings against Licensee.

8. This stipulation constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and there are no other agreements or understandings regarding any matter in question other than that expressly set forth herein.

9. Licensee shall appear before the Board for an interview in approximately four months, the exact date and time to be determined by the Board.

10. This stipulation shall remain in full force and effect until modified, amended or rescinded by the mutual agreement of the parties hereto.
