ORDER TERMINATING STIPULATION AND
DISSOLVING ENFORCEMENT ORDER

NOW, on this 8th day of June, 1991, comes on for hearing, the request of Bernardo G. Bilang, M.D. (hereafter "Licensee") for termination of Stipulation.

Licensee appears in person pro se. Litigation Counsel, Steve A. Schwarm, appears on behalf of the Board. There are no other appearances.

After reviewing the file and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board") makes the following findings of fact, conclusions of law and order:

1. On June 16, 1989, Licensee entered into a Stipulation with the Board which required Licensee to arrange for the monitoring and review of inpatient and outpatient treatment records by Seeley T. Feldmeyer, M.D. and Juan H. Resol, M.D. Licensee was also responsible for Dr. Feldmeyer and Dr. Resol to provide to the Board monthly reports of their review of Licensee's patient records.

Licensee also agreed to submit a monthly list of all controlled substances in Schedules II through IV prescribed by Licensee to patients on an outpatient basis each calendar month.

2. On June 16, 1989, the Board issued an Enforcement Order based upon the conditions as stated in the aforementioned Stipulation.

3. Licensee has submitted evidence in compliance with the above-mentioned Stipulation and Enforcement Order as well as insuring that Dr. Feldmeyer and Dr. Resol submitted monthly reports of their review of Licensee's patient records.

4. Licensee has requested that the aforementioned Stipulation be terminated and the Enforcement Order based thereon be dissolved.

5. The Stipulation between the Board and Licensee dated June 16, 1989, should be terminated and the Enforcement Order issued by the Board should be dissolved.

7. With the termination of the Stipulation and dissolution of the Enforcement Order, Licensee should be discharged from any restrictions thereby imposed on his license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED BY THE BOARD that the Stipulation dated June 16, 1989, between Licensee and the Board be terminated in its entirety and shall hereafter have no further force or effect; that the Enforcement Order based upon the Stipulation between Licensee and the Board dated June 16, 1989, be hereby dissolved; and that the license of Licensee to practice medicine

and surgery in the State of Kansas shall hereafter be without any restrictions or limitations.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
