### EX PARTE EMERGENCY ORDER OF SUSPENSION

**NOW** on this 29<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2018, this matter comes before the Board on Petitioner's Motion for *Ex Parte* Emergency Order of Suspension and for Emergency Proceedings.

Upon review of the agency record in KSBHA Docket No. 18-HA00057, including the Petition, Motions, and attached exhibits, the Presiding Officer finds, concludes and orders as follows:

- 1. On May 29, 2018, Petitioner filed a Petition alleging that Kyle D. Bleier, R.T., ("Licensee") committed violations of the Healing Arts Act and requesting disciplinary action against Licensee's license.
- 2. Petitioner also filed a Motion for *Ex Parte* Emergency Order of Suspension and for Emergency Proceedings ("Motion"). The Motion incorporated the allegations of the Petition by reference.
- 3. Based on the facts and documentary evidence as set forth and incorporated in the Motion at paragraphs 8 through 30, incorporated here by reference, the Board finds that there is cause to believe that grounds exist for disciplinary action, and an immediate danger exists, pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2838(c) and K.S.A. 77-536(c).

4. The Board further finds that the conclusions of law and policy contained in the Motion

at paragraphs 5 through 7, 23, and 30, each incorporated here by reference, justify the requested

emergency suspension pursuant to K.S.A. 77-536(c).

IT IS THEREFORE, ORDERED that the license of Kyle D. Bleier, R.T., is hereby

emergently SUSPENDED on a temporary basis pending an evidentiary hearing to determine if

there is adequate cause for the suspension to remain in effect during the proceedings on the

underlying Petition.
