JOURNAL ENTRY OF SATISFACTION OF CONSENT ORDER

COMES NOW the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”), by and through its Executive Director, Kathleen Selzler Lippert, a duly authorized representative of the Board, in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, as amended, and upon due consideration of the agency record and applicable statutes and regulations, and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, makes the following determinations:

1. On or about October 30, 2012, Licensee entered into a Consent Order with the Board for alleged violations of the Kansas Healing Arts Act, K.S.A. 65-2901, *et seq.* The Consent Order required Licensee attend and successfully complete a continuing education course for record-keeping, and to provide the Board documentation evidencing completion of the same by December 30, 2012.

2. On or about January 17, 2013, Board designee, Dr. Terry Webb, modified the requirements of the Consent Order. Dr. Webb amended requirements of the Consent Order based on the lack of live in-person record-keeping courses for physical therapists, and the costs associated with attending a similar course intended for another allied health profession.

3. The new requirements for the Consent Order required Licensee to complete twelve (12) hours of on-line continuing educational units related to record-keeping of patient

care. Following completion of the continuing education, Licensee was required to write a 500-word essay addressing how the information would affect his documentation of patient care in the future.

4. On or about February 20, 2013, Licensee submitted the appropriate amount of continuing educational units, and the required essay to the Board.

5. On or about March 6, 2013, Dr. Webb determined Licensee's submissions had fulfilled the modified requirements of Licensee's Consent Order.

6. Licensee has satisfactorily met all requirements of the Consent Order and shall have no further obligation for compliance.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Licensee is hereby discharged from all requirements of the Consent Order filed on October 30, 2012.


