**AMENDED¹ EMERGENCY ORDER OF TEMPORARY SUSPENSION AND
EMERGENCY PROCEEDINGS**

This matter comes before the Presiding Officer on a motion filed on August 2, 2019 (“Motion”) on behalf of the Disciplinary Panel of the Board (“Petitioner”) for an Ex Parte Emergency Order of Suspension and for Emergency Proceedings. The Motion incorporated the Petition for discipline filed on the same date (“Petition”). Upon consideration of the agency record, including all filings and attached exhibits, the presiding officer finds, concludes and orders as follows:

1. Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2838(c) and K.S.A. 77-536(c), there is reasonable cause to believe that:
 - a. grounds exist for disciplinary action; and
 - b. the immediate continuation in practice by James R. Bond, D.C. (“Licensee”) would constitute an imminent danger to the public health and safety.

2. The cause to believe that grounds exist for disciplinary action and the Licensee’s immediate continuation in practice would constitute an imminent danger to the public health and safety include the following:
 - a. The facts and documentary evidence as set forth and incorporated in the Motion and the Petition, all such facts and documentary evidence incorporated here by reference subject to the Protective Order that has been entered in this case.

 - b. After the Board held a hearing concerning Licensee, at which Licensee

attended and provided testimony, the Board issued an Order on August 29, 2018, which found reasonable suspicion existed that Licensee's ability to practice his profession with reasonable skill and safety to patients was impaired. Therefore, to affect the Board's mission of public protection, the Board ordered a [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] As more fully described in the Journal Entry entered in this case on March 15, 2019, incorporated here by reference, Licensee was given an extension of time to propose or [REDACTED] consistent with the policy. Licensee failed to do so. Therefore, the Board issued an Order on July 9, 2019 designating the entity to [REDACTED] no later than July 26, 2019. To date, Licensee has failed to schedule the ordered [REDACTED].

3. The presiding officer further finds that, in addition to the facts and law referenced above, K.S.A. 65-2801, K.S.A. 65-2836, K.S.A. 65-2837, and the policy consideration of the Board's duty of public protection provide supplemental reasonable grounds in law and policy to justify the requested emergency suspension under the circumstances of this case.

4. Therefore, pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2838(c) and K.S.A. 77-536(b), Licensee's license to practice chiropractic medicine is immediately temporarily suspended pending further proceedings and/or further Order of the Board.

5. Licensee is notified that the presiding officer may vacate this order upon notice that the Licensee has complied with the July 9, 2019 Order Designating Entity to Conduct an Evaluation.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that the Motion is **SUSTAINED**. The license of James R. Bond, D.C., is hereby **SUSPENDED** as described above on a temporary basis pending further proceedings and/or further Order of the Board.


