ORDER FOLLOWING CONFERENCE HEARING

NOW on this 27th day of June, 1997, this matter comes before the Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board") for conference proceedings regarding Applicant's Application for licensure filed in the Board of Healing Arts office to practice chiropractic in the State of Kansas. Charlene K. Abbott, Licensing Administrator, presents information to the Kansas Board of Healing Arts (hereinafter "Board"). Licensee appears in person.

After reviewing the file, hearing statements of the parties and being duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings of fact , conclusions of law and orders:

1. An Application for Endorsement was received from Applicant on December 18, 1996.
2. Dr. Bonebrake did not complete Part II of the National Boards of Chiropractic Examiners.
3. Dr. Bonebrake passed the California State written examination, plus a four-part practical exam. She has held a California license since 1983.
4. Dr. Bonebrake is requesting the Board grant Endorsement based on the California State examination in lieu of passage of the National Boards.
5. Notice of Conference Hearing setting this matter for hearing at 10:45 a.m., Friday,

June 27, 1997 was filed herein on June 12, 1997 and served on Applicant on that same date.

6. The Board finds that sufficient cause exists to grant Applicant's Application for licensure to practice chiropractic in the State of Kansas.

7. Upon payment of the appropriate fees, Applicant should be granted a license to practice chiropractic.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED as follows:


A. That upon payment of the appropriate fee, a license to practice chiropractic in the State of Kansas be granted to applicant.

B. That this is a Final Order and is effective upon service upon the parties. Any party may, within fifteen (15) days after service, file a Petition for Reconsideration. The filing of a Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking administrative or judicial review.


