SUMMARY ORDER DENYING APPLICATION

NOW, on this 18th day of July, 2005, comes on before Lawrence T. Buening, Jr., Executive Director of the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board"), the Application for Registration as a Physical Therapist filed by Gauri Borse ("Applicant"). After reviewing the file and being duly advised in the premises, the Executive Director makes the following findings and orders for and on behalf of the Board:

1. Applicant filed an Application for Registration as a Physical Therapist with the Board on February 4, 2003.
2. Applicant has provided information to the Board indicating she graduated from the School of Physical Therapy, Mumbai, Maharashtra, India with a degree of Bachelor of Science-Physical Therapy in November 1994.
3. The School of Physical Therapy of Mumbai, Maharashtra, India is not an educational program in physical therapy approved by the Board.
4. K.A.R. 100-29-3 provides that each person who received education from a school not approved by the Board shall submit with the application for registration an evaluation prepared for the state of Kansas by a Board approved credentialing agency.
5. On June 21, 2005, the Board received a Summary of Evaluation of Educational Credentials dated June 14, 2005, prepared by the International Consultants of Delaware, Inc.
6. International Consultants of Delaware, Inc. has been approved by the Board as a

credentialing agency.

7. K.A.R. 100-29-2 provides that if an applicant for registration received a degree from a program that was not approved by the Board at the time of an applicant's graduation, the Board may consider whether the program was equivalent to physical therapist schools that were approved by the American Physical Therapy Association at that time.

8. From the information provided as part of the Application, Applicant has not successfully completed the academic requirements of a program in physical therapy which is appropriate for registration of Applicant as a physical therapist in the state of Kansas. Applicant will need three (3) credit hours in humanities and two (2) credit hours in biological sciences to successfully complete the academic requirements required for licensure.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Application for Registration as a Physical Therapist filed by Gauri Dilip is deemed incomplete until Applicant provides proof of successful completion of three (3) credit hours in humanities and two (2) credit hours in biological sciences.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that this is a summary order. A party to whom a summary order is issued may file a written request for a hearing within 15 days following service of the summary order. If a hearing is not requested, the summary order shall become effective as a final order of the Board upon expiration of the time for requesting a hearing. 
