NOW, on this 9<sup>th</sup> day of March, 1987, the above matter comes on for hearing for dismissal by mutual agreement of the parties.


After reviewing the file and being duly advised in the premises, the Presiding Officer duly appointed in this matter finds as follows:

1. That, on November 1, 1986, the license of James D. Bowen, M.D. to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas was cancelled pursuant to the provisions of K.S.A. 65-2809 for failure to renew in accordance with provisions of said statute.

2. That, as a result of the cancellation of the license of James D. Bowen, M.D. to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas, James D. Bowen, M.D. no longer has the privilege to engage in the practice of any branch of the healing arts within the State of Kansas and, therefore, the Petition for Revocation, Suspension or Limitation of Licensee's license on file herein is thereby rendered moot.

3. That, the Petition for Revocation, Suspension or Limitation filed in the above-entitled matter on July 18, 1986 should be and is hereby dismissed in its entirety with prejudice.

IT IS THEREFORE BY THE PRESIDING OFFICER ORDERED that the Petition for Revocation, Suspension or Limitation of License filed in the above-entitled matter on July 18, 1986 be and is hereby dismissed with prejudice.
