FINAL ORDER FOLLOWING CONFERENCE HEARING

NOW, on this 28th day of June, 1997, this matter comes on for conference proceedings at the request of Danny Douglas Briggs, Jr., (hereafter "Applicant") to grant a third temporary registration pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2896d,

Charlene K. Abbott, Licensing Administrator, presented information to the Kansas Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board"). Applicant appears pro se.

After hearing statements from the parties and being duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings of facts, conclusions of law and order:

1) A June 16, 1997 request for a third temporary registration from Applicant was received in the Board office.

2) Notice of conference proceedings setting this matter for hearing at 10:15 a.m. on Saturday, June 28, 1997 was filed herein on June 17, 1997 and mailed to Applicant on that same date.

3) Applicant has applied for permanent registration as a physician's assistant, but has not passed an exam approved by the Board as required by K.S.A. 65-2896a(a)(3).

4) Applicant was granted a second temporary registration number, 9722098, to expire June 30, 1997.

5) Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2898d, not more than one temporary registration shall be permitted to any one person without the majority approval of the members of the Board.

6) Upon payment of the appropriate fees, Applicant should be granted a third temporary registration to expire February 15, 1998.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED as follows:

a. That upon payment of the appropriate fee, a third temporary registration be granted to Applicant to expire February 15, 1998.


b. That this is a Final Order and is effective upon service upon the parties. Any party may, within fifteen (15) days after service, file a Petition for

Reconsideration. The filing of a Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking administrative or judicial review.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
