ORDER GRANTING SECOND TEMPORARY REGISTRATION

NOW, on this 15th day of February, 1997, this matter comes on for conference proceedings at the request of Danny Douglas Briggs, Jr., (hereafter "Applicant") to grant a second temporary registration pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2896d.

Charlene K. Abbott, Licensing Administrator, presented information to the Kansas Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board"). There were no other appearances.

After hearing statements from the Licensing Administrator and being duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings of facts, conclusions of law and order:

1) A request for a second temporary registration from Applicant was received in the Board office on January 13, 1997.

2) Notice of conference proceedings setting this matter for hearing at 11:00 a.m. on February 15, 1997 was filed herein on January 31, 1997 and mailed to Applicant on that same date.

3) Applicant has applied for permanent registration as a physician's assistant, but has not passed an exam approved by the Board as required by K.S.A. 65-2896a(a)(3).

4) Applicant was granted temporary registration number, 9720058, which will expire on February 28, 1997.

5) Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2896d, not more than one temporary registration shall be permitted to any one person without the majority approval of the members of the Board.

6) Upon payment of the appropriate fees, Applicant should be granted a second temporary registration to expire June 30, 1997.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED as follows:

a. That upon payment of the appropriate fee, a second temporary registration be granted to Applicant to expire June 30, 1997.

b. That this is a Final Order and is effective upon service upon the parties. Any party may, within fifteen (15) days after service, file a Petition for Reconsideration. The filing of a Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking administrative or judicial review.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
