- 3) Applicant has applied for permanent registration as a physician's assistant, but has not passed an exam approved by the Board as required by K.S.A. 65-2896a(a)(3).
- 4) Applicant was granted a third temporary registration number, 9722098, which expired February 15, 1998.
- 5) Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2898d, not more than one temporary registration shall be permitted to any one person without the majority approval of the members of the Board.
- 6) Upon payment of the appropriate fees, Applicant should be granted a fourth temporary registration to expire June 13, 1998.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED as follows:

- a. That upon payment of the appropriate fee, a fourth temporary registration be granted to Applicant to expire June 13, 1998.
- b. That this is a Final Order and is effective upon service upon the parties.

 Any party may, within fifteen (15) days after service, file a Petition for

Reconsideration. The filing of a Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking administrative or judicial review.
