**FINAL ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR TERMINATION
OF MONITORING**

NOW on this 11th day of October 2013, comes before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board") the request of Matthew Britton L.R.T. ("Licensee") for termination of the monitoring requirements contained in the Consent Order filed June 16, 2009. Licensee appears in person and *pro se*. Jane Weiler, Associate Litigation Counsel, appears on behalf of the Respondent Board.

Pursuant to the authority granted to Board by K.S.A. 65-7301 *et seq.* and in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, the Board hereby enters this Final Order in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the agency record, hearing the statements and arguments of the parties, and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings, conclusions and order:

1. Matthew Britton, L.R.T. ("Licensee"), is licensed to engage in the practice of respiratory therapy in the State of Kansas, License No. 22-03200.

2. Licensee's last known mailing address provided to the Board is: **Confidential**

3. As a condition of being granted licensure, Licensee entered into a Consent Order with the Board which imposed monitoring requirements on Licensee which was filed on June 16, 2009.


7. On or about August 5, 2013, Licensee filed a request to terminate the monitoring requirements in the Consent Order.

8. On September 19, 2013, the Respondent Board filed a Response to Petition for Termination of Monitoring and submitted documentary evidence Confidential regarding Licensee's compliance.

9. Upon review of the evidence, the Board finds that Licensee has satisfactorily met all monitoring requirements of the Consent Order and that termination of monitoring is warranted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, BY THE KANSAS STATE BOARD OF HEALING ARTS that Licensee's request for termination of the monitoring requirement contained in the Consent Order filed June 16, 2009, is hereby **GRANTED**.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that this is a Final Order. A Final Order is effective upon service, and service of a Final Order is complete upon mailing. Pursuant to K.S.A. 77-529, Licensee may petition the Board for Reconsideration of a Final Order within fifteen (15) days following service of the final order. Additionally, a party to an agency proceeding may seek judicial review of a Final Order by filing a petition in the District Court, as authorized by K.S.A. 77-601, *et seq.* Reconsideration of a Final Order is not a prerequisite to judicial review. A petition for judicial review is not timely unless filed within **30 days** following service of the Final Order. 
