FINAL ORDER

NOW ON THIS 17th day of April, 2009, this matter comes on for hearing on Licensee's Request for Termination of Limitations. Licensee appears in person, *pro se*. Stacy Bond, Associate Litigation Counsel, appears for the Board. There are no other appearances.

Having the agency record before it, hearing the statements and arguments of the parties and being duly advised in the premises, the Board finds, concludes and orders as follows:

1. On February 16, 2007 a Final Order was filed with the Board granting Licensee's request for licensure with limitations.
2. Amongst other provisions, Licensee was required to have his professional practice monitored by a Board-approved, Kansas-licensed physician and maintain a daily log for a period of one year.
3. A Joint Motion for Supplemental Monitoring Orders was filed on April 17, 2007, which set out the number of Licensee's charts that the monitor was to review.

4. The Final Order provided that the limitations were not self-limiting and that Licensee may petition the Board for termination of the limitations after a period of one year.
5. On or about February 11, 2009, Licensee sent a letter to Board Litigation Counsel requesting termination of the limitations.
6. No problems have been reported to the Board by the monitor.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that Licensee's Request for Termination of Limitations is GRANTED.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that this is a final order. A final order is effective upon service. A party to an agency proceeding may seek judicial review of a final order by filing a petition in the District Court as authorized by K.S.A. 77-601, et seq. Reconsideration of a final order is not a prerequisite to judicial review. A petition for judicial review is not timely unless filed within 30 days following service of the final order. A copy of any petition for judicial review must be served upon the Board's Executive Director at 235 SW. Topeka Blvd., Topeka, KS 66603.
