ORDER GRANTING THIRD TEMPORARY REGISTRATION

NOW, on this 12th day of March, 1994, this matter comes on for conference proceedings at the request of Deborah K. Brown, P.A. (hereafter "Registrant") to grant a third temporary registration pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2896d.

Applicant appears in person pro se. Charlene K. Abbott, Licensing Administrator, appears on behalf of the Board. An appearance was also made by Tom Simpson, M.D. on behalf of Registrant.

After reviewing the files, hearing statements of Registrant and being duly advised in the premises, the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board") makes the following findings of facts, conclusions of law and order:

- 1) A request for a third temporary registration was filed by Registrant on February 2, 1994.
- 2) Notice of Conference Hearing setting this matter for hearing at 8:30 a.m. on March 12, 1994 was filed in the Board

office on February 25, 1994 and mailed to Registrant by United States mail on that same date.

3) Registrant has applied for permanent registration as a physician's assistant, but has not passed an exam approved by the Board as required by K.S.A. 65-2896a(a)(3).

4) Registrant was granted a first temporary registration which expired February 15, 1993. A second temporary registration, 93-00191 was granted at the February 13, 1993 Board Meeting which expired on February 14, 1994.

5) Pursuant to K.S.a. 65-2896d, not more than one temporary registration shall be permitted to any one person without the majority approval of the members of the Board.

6) Upon payment of the appropriate fee, Registrant should be granted a third temporary registration until the results from the NCCPA examination to be administered in October, 1994 become known to the Board.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED as follows:

a. That upon payment of the appropriate fee, a third temporary registration be granted to Registrant until the Board receives the results from the NCCPA examination to be administered in October, 1994.

b. In the event Registrant fails to pass the NCCPA examination to be administered in October, 1994, the third temporary registration hereby granted to Registrant should expire and be cancelled as of the date of the next regularly scheduled

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meeting of the Board following the date the notification of failure is provided to the Board.

c. That this is a Final Order and is effective upon service upon the parties. Any party may, within 15 days after service, file a Petition for Reconsideration. The filing of a Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking administrative or judicial review.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
