**FINAL ORDER TERMINATING MONITORING**

NOW on this 9<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2016, the above-captioned matter comes before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board") on the Motion to Terminate Monitoring filed by Richard L. Brown, M.D. ("Licensee") on September 12, 2016. Licensee appears in person and *pro se*. Jane Weiler, Associate Litigation Counsel, appears on behalf of the agency.

Pursuant to the authority granted to Board by K.S.A. 65-2801, *et seq.* and in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, the Board hereby enters this Final Order in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the agency record, hearing the statements and arguments of the parties, receiving exhibits into evidence, and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings of fact, conclusions and order:

1. On August 20, 2016, the Board entered a Final Order publically censuring Licensee's license, ordering Licensee to pay the costs of the administrative proceedings in the amount of \$3,818.85, and imposing non-disciplinary monitoring requirements on Licensee's license until at least December 5, 2016.
2. Licensee has paid all costs of the administrative proceedings in full.
3. Licensee's Motion requests that the monitoring requirements in the Final Order be terminated based on his fulfillment of the same.

4. The evidence presented demonstrates that Licensee has satisfactorily met all of the monitoring requirements imposed by the Final Order.

3. The Board concludes that termination of the monitoring requirements is warranted in the circumstances.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED BY THE KANSAS STATE BOARD OF HEALING ARTS** that the monitoring requirements imposed by the Final Order are hereby **TERMINATED** and that Licensee shall have no further obligations for compliance.
