ORDER NUNC PRO TUNC


NOW, on this *21st* day of December, 2016, the Board determines that the Final Order Terminating Monitoring filed in this matter on December 13, 2016, erroneously stated in paragraph 1 that the Board's previous Final Order publically censuring Licensee's license was entered on August 20, 2016, when in fact, the Final Order was entered on August 20, 2013.

WHEREFORE, Paragraph 1 of the Final Order Terminating Monitoring is hereby amended to read:

On August 20, 2013, the Board entered a Final Order publically censuring Licensee's license, ordering Licensee to pay the costs of the administrative proceedings in the amount of \$3,818.85, and imposing non-disciplinary monitoring requirements on Licensee's license until at least December 5, 2016.


