## FINAL ORDER FOLLOWING CONFERENCE HEARING

NOW on this 12th day of June, 1992, comes on for consideration by the conference proceeding before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board") sitting as a whole the telephone request of Michael V. Canale, M.D. (hereafter "Applicant") for the Board to approve Fifth Pathway in lieu of passage of an examination given by the Educational Commission for Foreign Graduates.

After reviewing the file and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings of fact, and order:

- 1. Applicant filed an application for license to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas on March 9, 1992 in the Board office.
- 2. As part of said application, Applicant indicated he had performed a Fifth Pathway program from January 1980 through December 1980 at St. Joseph's Medical Center in Yonkers, New York.
- 3. As indicated on said application, Applicant is a graduate of Universidad Autonoma de Guadalajara, Jalisco, Mexico.

4. That K.S.A. 65-2873 provides that if an Applicant is a foreign medical graduate, the Applicant must pass an examination given by the Educational Commission for Foreign Medical Graduates.

5. That based upon the past positions taken by the Educational Commission on foreign medical graduates and the Board, an acceptable Fifth Pathway will serve to meet the requirements of K.S.A. 65-2873(d).

IT IS THEREFORE BY THE BOARD ORDERED that the Fifth Pathway program taken by Applicant at St. Joseph's Medical Center in Yonkers, New York from January 1980 through December 1980 is acceptable and equivalent to passage of the examination given by Educational Commission for Foreign Medical Graduates as set forth in K.S.A. 65-2873(d).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this is a Final Order and is effective upon service upon the parties. Any party may, within fifteen (15) days after service, file a Petition for Reconsideration. The filing of a Petition for Reconsideration is not a prerequisite for seeking administrative or judicial review.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
