FINAL ORDER GRANTING LICENSURE BY ENDORSEMENT

NOW on this 11th day of April 2014, comes before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board") the application of Joycelin Canavan, MD ("Applicant") for a license by endorsement to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas. Applicant appears in person and *pro se*. Reese Hays, Litigation Counsel, appears on behalf of the Respondent Board.

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Board by the Kansas Healing Arts Act, K.S.A. 65-2801, *et seq.* and in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act K.S.A. 77-501, *et seq.*, the Board hereby enters this Final Order following a formal hearing in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the agency record and exhibit offered by Applicant, hearing the testimony of Applicant, and otherwise being duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings, conclusions and order:

1. On or about March 13, 2014, Applicant submitted an application to the Board for a license by endorsement to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas.
2. Applicant requests that she be granted licensure by endorsement pursuant to K.S.A. 65-2833, based on her active medical license in the British Columbia, Canada which was granted in 2012, and has not been subject to discipline.
3. Dr. Canavan graduated in 2006 from the University of Dublin, Trinity College School of Medicine in Dublin, Ireland.

4. In June 2011, Applicant completed a five-year residency in radiation oncology at the Dalhousie University Faculty of Medicine in Nova Scotia, Canada. The residency was accredited by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons (“RCPS”).

5. In 2012, Applicant completed a one-year fellowship at the British Columbia Cancer Agency in British Columbia, Canada.

6. Applicant passed all steps of the United States Medical Licensing Examination (“USMLE”) within ten years.


7. From February 2012 until September 2013, Applicant actively practiced as a Radiation Oncologist at the British Columbia Cancer Agency in British Columbia, Canada.

8. On March 20, 2014, Applicant was granted full licensure to practice medicine and surgery in Missouri. Applicant’s Missouri medical license is currently active with no disciplinary actions.

9. The Board finds that the Applicant has demonstrated satisfactory fulfillment of the requirements of K.S.A. 65-2833 to be granted a license by endorsement to practice chiropractic in the State of Kansas.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, BY THE KANSAS STATE BOARD OF HEALING ARTS that Applicant is hereby GRANTED a license by endorsement to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas.


