FINAL ORDER FOLLOWING CONFERENCE HEARING

NOW, on this 6th day of December, 2003, comes on for Conference Hearing before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board") the Application for Licensure to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas filed by Jose A. Cancelas, M.D. ("Applicant").

Charlene K. Abbott, Licensing Administrator, presented information before the Board. Applicant appeared in person *pro se*.

After reviewing the file, hearing the statements of Ms. Abbott and Applicant and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board finds as follows:

1. On June 20, 2003, Applicant filed an Application for Licensure to receive a license to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Kansas.
2. As part of the Application, Applicant provided evidence that he finished the degree program in medicine and surgery at the Faculty of Medicine, Autonomous University of Madrid, Madrid, Spain in June 1989 and was issued the degree of doctor in medicine and surgery on April 23, 1990.

3. Faculty of Medicine, Autonomous University of Madrid is not an accredited medical school.

4. K.S.A. 65-2873(c)(2) provides that an applicant from a school that is not accredited may be granted a license if the applicant has completed three years of postgraduate training as approved by the Board.

5. The Board has adopted K.A.R. 100-6-2(b) that requires applicants who graduated from an unaccredited school of medicine to provide proof of completion of at least two years of postgraduate training approved by the council of education of the American Medical Association or its equivalent.

6. Applicant has completed four years of postgraduate training at the Hospital Ramon Y Cajal in Madrid, one year of fellowship at Children's Hospital Medical Center in Cincinnati, Ohio, and one year of fellowship at Hoxworth Blood Center in Cincinnati, Ohio. The fellowship at Hoxworth Blood Center has been approved by the council of education of the American Medical Association.

7. Only one year of Applicant's postgraduate training was approved by the council of education of the American Medical Association.

8. In addition to the postgraduate training described in paragraph 6, Applicant successfully completed fellowships at Hospital Duran I Reynals in Barcelona, Spain, and Erasmus University of Rotterdam, Rotterdam, Netherlands, and has been head of the flow cytometry labs at both locations.


9. Applicant's completion of four years of postgraduate training in Madrid, the one-year fellowship at Children's Hospital Medical Center and the fellowships in Barcelona and Rotterdam are at least equivalent to a year of postgraduate training that was approved by the council of education of the American Medical Association.

10. Applicant meets the requirements for licensure under K.S.A. 65-2873 and K.A.R. 100-6-2(b) and is eligible for a license.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the above findings are made the order of the Board and that Applicant is eligible for a license to practice medicine and surgery under the provisions of K.S.A. 65-2873.
