JOURNAL ENTRY

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NOW on this 19th day of October, 1996, comes before the Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board") for conference proceedings the Application For Endorsement submitted by Ralph Cardin, D.C. (hereafter "Applicant").

Charlene K. Abbott, Licensing Administrator, presented information before the Board. Applicant appears <u>pro</u> <u>se</u>. There were no other appearances.

After reviewing the file, hearing the statements of the parties and being duly advised in the premises, the Board finds as follows:

 Applicant's Application for Endorsement was received on April 30, 1996.

 Notice of Conference Hearing setting this matter for hearing at 9:30 a.m. on August 17, 1996 was filed herein on August
1996 and served on Applicant on that same date. 3. At the Board Meeting on August 17, 1996, Applicant appeared in person pro se and confidential appeared in support of Applicant's application. The Board found no cause to deny Applicant a full, unlimited license to practice chiropractic in the State of Kansas based upon the grounds set forth in K.S.A. 1995 Supp. 65-2836.

4. A Final Order Following Conference Hearing was filed on September 9, 1996 and served upon Applicant the same date.

5. By letter filed on October 2, 1996, Applicant notified the Board's Executive Director of his request to withdraw his application.

6. A Notice of Conference Hearing was filed on October 3, 1996 and mailed to Applicant that same date setting conference proceedings for 10:45 a.m., Saturday, October 19, 1996. Ms. Abbott presented information before the Board. Dr. Cardin appeared <u>pro</u> <u>se</u>. There were no other appearances. Dr. Cardin advised the Board that he had changed his plans to practice in the State of Kansas and intended to seek licensure to practice in another state in the near future.

After hearing the statements of the parties, the Board has determined that the Final Order Following Conference Hearing filed on September 9, 1996 in the above-entitled matter be rescinded in its entirety. Applicant's Application For Endorsement submitted on April 30, 1996 is voluntarily withdrawn; no further proceedings are required or necessary and this matter should be dismissed.
