FINAL ORDER FOLLOWING CONFERENCE HEARING

NOW on this 8th day of December, 2001, comes on for conference hearing before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (hereafter "Board") the Application for Institutional License in Medicine and Surgery filed by Waldeck Charles, M.D. (hereafter "Applicant"). Applicant appears in person *pro se*. Lawrence T. Buening, Jr., Executive Director, presented information before the Board. There were no other appearances.

After reviewing the file, including the information Applicant provided with the Application when it was first submitted February 21, 2001, the Board finds as follows:

1. Applicant submitted an Application for Institutional License in Medicine and Surgery on February 21, 2001. That Application was denied by Summary Order filed May 22, 2001, since Applicant did not appear to have any prospects for employment as required by K.S.A. 2000 Supp. 65-2895 to qualify for an institutional license.

2. On December 3, 2001, Applicant resubmitted the Application for Institutional License in Medicine and Surgery and provided information that he would be employed at Larned State Hospital if he was granted an Institutional License.

3. Applicant has executed and filed a Voluntary Entry of Appearance and Waiver of Notice in which he entered his appearance and waived the requirement under the Kansas Administrative

Procedure Act that notice be given at least 10 days prior to hearing.

4. Applicant's Application established that he received his Doctor of Medicine degree in December 1982 from the Universidad Cetec (Cetec), located in Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic.

5. According to information available to the Board, instruction began at Cetec in 1980 and the school was closed in 1984.

6. K.S.A. 2000 Supp. 65-2895 grants the Board the authority to grant an institutional license to a person who is a graduate of an accredited school of the healing arts or a school which has been in operation for not less than 15 years.

7. Cetec is not accredited by the Board and was not in operation for 15 or more years.

8. Following deliberations and announcing the aforementioned findings of fact, the Board offered Applicant the option of requesting that his Application be voluntarily withdrawn rather than the Board proceeding to issue conclusions of law based upon the findings and Applicant orally requested that he be allowed to withdraw his Application and such request was granted by the Board.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant's Application for Institutional License in Medicine and Surgery be voluntarily withdrawn and no further proceedings are required or necessary.


