**FINAL ORDER GRANTING LICENSE**

NOW, on this 26<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2003, comes on for hearing before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board") the Application for Licensure as a Respiratory Therapist filed by Luqi Chi ("Applicant"). Applicant appears in person. Lawrence T. Buening, Jr., Executive Director of the Board presents information to the Board.

After review the file, hearing statements of the Executive Director and being duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings, conclusions and orders:

1. Applicant filed an Application for Licensure as a Respiratory Therapist on February 28, 2003.
2. As part of the application, Applicant provided evidence that she had attended respiratory therapy classes at the University of Kansas in the Spring, Summer and Fall, 1991 terms and received a certificate dated July 27, 2001, that she had fulfilled all requirements for completion of a course of study for respiratory therapist.
3. Applicant also provided information that she received the degree of Bachelor of Medicine from the North China Coal Mining Medical College in 1984 and the degree of Master of Medicine in respiratory disease from the Military Postgraduate Medical School in 1997.
4. The Board has recognized and approved the University of Kansas as an educational program in respiratory therapy for purposes of licensure in the state of Kansas.


5. Applicant has provided evidence satisfactory to the Board of having successfully completed an educational program in respiratory therapy approved by the Board and has otherwise met the requirements for licensure as a respiratory therapist established by the statutes and the rules and regulations adopted by the Board.

6. The Application for Licensure as a Respiratory Therapist filed by Applicant should be granted and a license to practice respiratory therapy in the state of Kansas should be issued to Applicant effective April 26, 2003.


