FINAL ORDER GRANTING LICENSURE

NOW on this 14th day of April 2017, comes before the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts ("Board") the application of Andrea Chiavarini, MD ("Applicant") for a license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas. Applicant appears in person and *with counsel*, Robert Eye. Reese Hays, Litigation Counsel, appears on behalf of the Respondent Board.

Pursuant to the authority granted to the Board by the Kansas Healing Arts Act, K.S.A. 65-2801, *et seq.* and in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act K.S.A. 77-501, *et seq.*, the Board hereby enters this Final Order in the above-captioned matter. After reviewing the agency record, hearing the statements and arguments of the parties, receiving exhibits into evidence and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, the Board makes the following findings, conclusions and order:

1. On or about May 13, 2016, Dr. Chiavarini submitted an application to the Board for a license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas. Such application was complete and filed with the Board on December 20, 2016.

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7.	The Board concludes that Dr. Chiavarini has met the technical requirements for
licensure and does not find any violations of the Healing Arts Act.	
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IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, BY THE KANSAS STATE BOARD OF HEALING ARTS that Dr. Chiavarini is hereby GRANTED a license to practice medicine and surgery in the State of Kansas. IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that Dr. Chiavarini be subject to monitoring
