**JOURNAL ENTRY OF SATISFACTION**


COMES NOW the Kansas State Board of Healing Arts (“Board”), by and through its Executive Director, Kathleen Selzler Lippert, a duly authorized representative of the Board, in accordance with the provisions of the Kansas Administrative Procedure Act, K.S.A. 77-501 *et seq.*, as amended, and upon due consideration of the agency record, the applicable statutes and regulations, and being otherwise duly advised in the premises, makes the following determinations:

1. On November 22, 2017, the Board issued a Summary Order.
2. The Summary Order required evidence of completion of 145.5 continuing education hours, including at least 55.5 Category I credits, and payment for the civil fine in the amount of \$500.00 on or before December 15, 2017.
3. The Summary Order, upon effectiveness as a final order 15 days after filing, indefinitely suspended Licensee’s license until she met the requirements of the Summary Order.
4. Licensee met all requirements of the Summary Order prior to the date the Summary Order became effective as a final order.
5. As the requirements of the Summary Order were met prior to the effective date of the Summary Order, Licensee’s license was not suspended.
6. Licensee has no further obligation for compliance with the Summary Order.


